

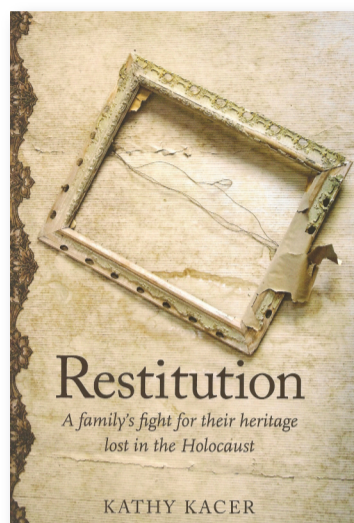

Restitution:

A Family's Fight For Their Heritage Lost in the Holocaust

Restitution begins in a small town near Prague as the Reeser family flees the Nazis, leaving everything behind including some valuable paintings. In 1989, the paintings were found in a private home in Prague and were returned to the family with help from two unlikely sources – a mid-level diplomat at the Canadian embassy in Prague, and a daring Czech art smuggler. From sneaking the paintings into the Canadian embassy in the dead of night to rolling them up and shipping them past the Communist authorities, they went to great lengths, and some risk, to help return the paintings to their owners. Ms. Kacer, a child of Holocaust survivors, is best known as a children's author, having won several honors with her books, several of them in the Holocaust Remembrance Series for Young Readers.
