

Ethics & Diversity Training for Law Enforcement Professionals

Since 2005, the Dallas Holocaust Museum/Center for Education and Tolerance has provided ethics and diversity training to more than 900 law enforcement officers who are being trained for supervisory positions in their respective departments. From sergeants to chiefs, these officers have come from all over the United States, and even Canada. The program consists of docent-led tours of the museum's permanent exhibit, historical background and discussion of the role of German police battalions during the Holocaust by museum staff, and the testimony of a Holocaust Survivor (by request).

The theme of the Law Enforcement Program centers around decision making, choices based on personal values and ethics. The literature used as the historical context of the program is *Ordinary Men* by Christopher Browning, which is the story of Police Battalion 101, who were an active part of the "Final Solution" to the Jewish question during the Holocaust. Most of these 500 men were responsible for thousands of murders in Eastern Poland; however, what we focus on are the decisions made by some of them to not participate in these pogroms perpetrated by the Nazis by refusing to murder the children, men, women, and elderly in that area of Poland.

This program, which costs only \$4 per person for groups of 15 or more, is open to all Law Enforcement groups interested in this type of ethics/diversity training.
